#### What is the difference between SDSS and NDIS?

The SDSS Program supports schools to enhance the learning outcomes for eligible students who require significant educational adjustments. The SDSS organisations are funded by the department and their services are engaged by schools to work on the educational goals of students.


NDIS services are focused on supporting people with disability in their daily lives and do not include supports within schools to access the curriculum. NDIS funding is allocated to parents of students with disability under a NDIS participant plan, with parents directly engaging a provider.

However, it is equally vital that we listen to the voices of our autistic community, across the life span, who advocate for more than just awareness.
